The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation invites sealed bids in two bid system i.e. technical and price bid from reputed and experienced firms/service providers for installation of Geo-Tubes at Pedhacheruvu, Khajaguda, Hyderabad for treating the water of lake.

The focus of the proposal is obtaining services to reduce the pollution load to Pedhacheruvu, Khajaguda, Hyderabad.

The EOI will be available for download from the GHMC website i.e. <https://www.ghmc.gov.in/>

1. The bidder shall have successfully delivered services for at least one similar work in India. Similar works means work of installation, commissioning & providing services for removal of pollution from effluents/ sewage through ready to deploy modular treatment plants of at least 15 MLD capacity successfully. The bidder would be required to furnish documentary proof from the concerned agency (for whom the work was undertaken) towards successfully completing the similar work.
2. The average annual turnover of the bidder during the last three financial years ending 31.3.2019 should not be less than 1.00 crore. The bidder shall submit a certificate issued by Chartered Accountant and/ or Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account for the above financial years.
3. The bidder shall furnish documentary proof of owning, leasing and/ or possessing adequate equipment and staff to undertake execution and achieving targets and milestone as per the accepted, time schedule of the work.
4. Documentary proof of installation, commissioning & services of modular treatment plants for effluent/ sewage treatment with at least 15 MLD capacity plant in India by the bidder in the past.
5. In the case of Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium, the JV/Consortium shall fulfil the criteria mentioned and submit the proof of document as single or JV/Consortium (Maximum three partners are allowed in the JV). The bidders/JV partners shall submit the list of all ongoing works / completed anywhere in Indian of similar nature; Documentary proof of specific performance report issued by the Client for each projects to be submitted.
6. All members of the JV shall jointly meet the qualifying norms in respect to work experience & turnover requirement.
7. Bidder should not have been black listed by any Central/State/Government agency and submit an undertaking on firm's letter head in this effect.

8. Last date for submission of bid is 18.04.2019 up to 5.00 pm and the technical bid will be opened on the same day at 5.30pm.
9. The acceptance of a bid rests with the GHMC, which does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid and reserves itself the right and authority to reject any or all of the bids received without assigning any reason. The bid in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
10. A bidder while submitting the bid shall quote in figures as well as in words the rate(s) for each item of work as per prescribed format. The amount for each item shall be worked out and the requisite totals should be given.
11. All rates shall be quoted on the prescribed form in the price bid.
12. On acceptance of the bid, the name of the authorized representative(s) of the service provider who shall be responsible for taking instructions from GHMC shall be communicated to the GHMC.
13. The bid shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 06 months from the date of opening of bids.
14. It will be obligatory on the part of the bidder to sign the bid documents on each page.
15. Where bidder voluntarily offers a rebate for payment within a stipulated period, this may be considered.
16. The bidder shall acquaint them with the quantum and nature of work and working conditions at the site and locality at their own cost and no claim shall what so ever be entertained in this regards.
17. The bid is non-transferable.
18. Disqualification:
Bids may be disqualified if any of the stipulated parameters listed in the “eligibility criteria” are not complied with.
 - a. If any of the documents sought to support the information given by bidder is not enclosed/submitted.
 - b. Wrong information/declarations have been furnished
 - c. The bid is received after the due date and time indicated there in.
 - d. If any firm (s) attempts to influence the bid process.
 - e. If the competitor disregards any of the conditions of the competition.

The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation invites sealed bids in two bid system i.e. technical and price bid from reputed and experienced firms/service providers for installation of Geo-Tubes at Pedhacheru, Khajaguda, Hyderabad for treating the water of lake from registered and authorized agencies having experience and expertise in the similar field of work described in the scope of work for a period of Two years extendable for a further period of one or more year on mutual consent on the same terms & conditions for proposed work specified below:

Place of service is at Pedhacheru Khajaguda, Hyderabad and other lakes in GHMC area depending on the necessity

1. Brief description of works:-

i. Area of services:-

The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation invites sealed bids in two bid system i.e. technical and price bid from reputed and experienced firms/service providers for installation of Geo-Tubes at Pedhacheru, Khajaguda, Hyderabad for treating the water of lake.

ii. Scope of Services

The details of the services to be provided by the Service Provider which broadly includes, but is not limited to, the followings is given below. Details of services are given in Appendix-I.

- Cleaning of floating materials from the drain at the point of installation of the Geo-Tubes to ensure no discharge of floating material to Down stream of the Geo-Tubes.
- Desilting and desludging of the stretch identified by GHMC during the period of Contract and / or as required for better operation and outcome of Geo-Tubes.
- Proper disposal of Sludge and other solid waste collected from the drain including its transportation
- Treatment of drain water to improve the water quality on 24 hour basis for Two years at no capital cost for the Geo-Tubes by GHMC.
- The effluent quality of the proposed Geo-Tubes before discharge to the drain at down stream should be minimum of the following to qualify for the bid:
 - A. Less than 30 mg/l of BOD (equivalent of 20 mg/l of TOC).
 - B. The suspended solids should be <50 mg/L.

iii. Language of Bid /Contract:

The language of the Bid shall be in English and all correspondence, drawings etc. shall conform to English language.

iv. Duration of Contract:

The Contract period shall be Two years from the date of contract, which may be further extended for a period of one or more year(s) based on satisfactory performance, cost implication and mutually agreed terms and conditions.

v. Performance Monitoring:

- (a) The performance monitoring of the Geo-Tubes shall be based on the data generated by Real Time Water Quality and Quantity Monitoring System (RTWQMS) at upstream and downstream. The difference in pollution load shall be the basis for assessing the performance of the system and shall be basis for payment purposes. The reduction in pollution load shall be calculated as follows:

$$\text{Pollution Load}_x = (I_f \times I_c) - (O_f \times O_c) - B_f \times B_c$$

Where	X-	Pollutant of concern (POC) - Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Total Organic Carbon (TOC) and Total Nitrogen (TN)
	$I_f \& O_f$	Inlet and Outlet Flow (cum/hr) of Geo-Tubes
	$I_c \& O_c$	Concentration of POC at inlet and outlet of Geo-Tubes
	$B_f \& B_c$	Flow and Concentration of POC in the main channel (Bypass)

- (b) The RTWQMS shall be calibrated as per the guided frequency prescribed in Guidelines for Online Continuous Monitoring System for Effluent” published by Central Pollution Control Board.
- (c) GHMC or its authorized agent will be performing the validation of data and will be witnessing the calibration. The accuracy and other details as specified in the said document shall be followed. Deviation or provision not covered in the document with regard to quality of data generated, system calibration, data validation, communication, logging, storage and other aspects necessary to have a reliable set of data for payment and for dissemination in public domain, shall be articulated in the contract document of on scientifically and mutually agreed basis between GHMC and the bidder before commencement of the contract.
- (d) The performance of the Geo-Tubes and other works as specified in the scope of work shall be monitored and assessed by a local committee constituted by Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation with Hyderabad Metro Water Supply & Sewerage Board and Telangana Pollution Control Board. The Committee will be giving its monthly progress report to the GHMC.
- (e) The payment shall be made to the bidder by 15th of the following month positively. The data on pollution reduction and the criteria set out for eligibility for payment shall be derived from the data available at GHMC. The bidder shall raise payment invoice for his services in the 1st week of following month based on the criteria and service extended within the provision of the contract.

- (f) Online Monitoring Systems shall be installed by the bidder and data shall be shared by the bidder with the GHMC. The performance of the services will be monitored by the committee constituted by the GHMC. The payments will be released based on the certification of satisfactory service by the Committee.

vi. Pre Bid Site Inspection:

- (a) The interested bidders are advised to visit the site prior to the bid submission and get themselves acquainted with the actual site conditions and may hold discussions with the concerned authorities of GHMC, if so require. However no travelling and any other cost / expense shall be payable for this purpose.
- (b) Where necessary, before submitting the Bid the Bidder should inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and shall satisfy itself about form and nature of the Site, the quantities and nature of the work/service and materials necessary for the completion of the works/services, means of access to the site, the accommodation it may require, and in general, obtain all necessary information as to risk, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect its bid. No extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.

vii. Clarification by Bidder:

Intending Bidder will be allowed to seek clarification in specifications, Conditions of Contract, etc. in writing to GHMC, within 48 hours before the pre-bid meeting, GHMC will communicate such clarifications to all the intending Bidder who have purchased or downloaded the bid document from the GHMC in writing before submission of bid. All such communication like addendum, amendment and clarifications shall form part of the bid documents.

viii. Pre Bid Meeting:

All bidders who have purchased or downloaded the bid documents are encouraged to attend to the pre-bid meeting to be held at in the chambers of The Chief Engineer(HA), 5th Floor, GHMC, Hyderabad on 12.04.2019 at 11.30 AM

2. Method of submitting the bid application:

- i. At any time prior to the Submission Deadline, the GHMC may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative, or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, amend the Bidding Documents by addendum. These shall be made available only on the GHMC website. All relevant information like minutes of pre-bid meeting and response to the bidder's query shall only be available in GHMC website
- ii. It is bidder responsibility, who purchase or download the bid document, to contact with GHMC and check regularly on the GHMC website before submission of its Bid. All these addendum, amendment and clarification shall be deemed to be part of the bid document and it will be assumed that the information contained therein has been taken into account by the Bidder in its Bid.
- iii. In order to afford prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment

into account while preparing their Bids, the GHMC may, at its discretion, extend the Submission Deadline. Details of time extension, if any will be provided in the GHMC web site.

3. Documents required with the technical bid:

- i. Self-attested copies of the documents mentioned in Appendix-II are to be annexed with the technical bid, failing which the bid will be rejected.
- ii. The bidder shall sign on each page of bid document for acceptance of all terms and conditions.

4. Submission of Bids:

- i. Bids which do not comply with this instruction shall be summarily rejected.
- ii. Necessary clarification if any required by GHMC shall be furnished by the bidder within the time given by GHMC for the same. The GHMC is at liberty to verify any oral documents submitted by the bidder, even by referring to third parties.
- iii. It should be clearly understood by the bidder that no further opportunity shall be given to them to modify or withdraw any stipulation at any stages of the contract.
- iv. The bid form shall be filled in by the bidder clearly, neatly and accurately. Any alteration, erasers or over-writing will render the bid invalid. Alteration neatly carried out and attested over the full signature of bidder, however, is permitted in exceptional circumstance but not as a matter of right.

5. Last Date for Submission

Bids shall be received not later than the time and date specified in the Bid Notice. In the event that the specified date for the submission of Bid is declared a holiday, the offers will be received up to the appointed time on the next working day.

6. Modifications and Withdrawal of Offers

No modification of the bid is possible once it is submitted.

7. Opening of bid

- (a) The bid i.e. technical bid will be opened in GHMC Office. The bidder will be at liberty to be present either in person or through an authorized representative at the time of opening of the bids.
- (b) At the stipulated time of opening, Envelope No.1 shall be opened first. The offers from those service providers who are unable to unconditionally accept bid conditions and Valid documentary proof of eligibility criteria will be rejected and Envelope No 2 containing bid documents shall not be opened.

- (c) The price bid of only those bid will be opened whose technical bid are found to be acceptable as per the evaluation criteria for technical bids mentioned in Appendix-II.
- (d) In the event of more than one bidder becomes L1, the Competent Authority in GHMC, reserves the right to select one of the L1 bidders based upon various norms like quality of work experience, number of years in operation and other credentials like work completion certificate of any Central Government / State Government Undertaking/ Organisation.

8. Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsiveness:

- i. For evaluation / examination of technical & price bids, an independent selection committee will be formed and the price bids will be opened only in respect of eligible and technical qualified bidders in accordance with the eligibility and evaluation criteria mentioned in Appendix-II. Information relating to examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other persons, not initially concerned with such process until the award to the successful bidder has been announced. Any effort by a bidder to influence the Employer (GHMC) processing of bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of the bidder's bid.
- ii. A substantially responsive bid is one that conforms to all the terms and conditions and specifications of the bidding document without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the work in consistent with the bidding documents.
- iii. Employer's rights or the bidder's obligations under the contract, or whose rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids.
- iv. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Employer and may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal and the non-conforming deviations or reservations.

9. CORRUPT PRACTICES:

Any bribe, commission advantage offered or promised by or on behalf of the bidder to any officer or servant of the GHMC shall (in addition to any criminal liability which the bidder may incur) debar his bid from being considered, canvassing on the part or on behalf of the bidder will also make his bid liable to rejection.

PRICE BID

1. I/WE, submit the price bid for appointment as Service provider at GHMC.
2. I/We thoroughly examined and understood instruction to bids, terms & conditions of contract given in the invitation to bid and those contained in the general conditions of contract and its appendix and the amendment, addendum & clarification issued by GHMC till the date of submission of Bid documents and agree to abide by them.
3. I/We hereby offer to provide the staff the basic minimum wages notified by the Govt. as the case may be, applicable at the time of award of the contract for the contract for the entire tenure of the contract. I/WE undertake that I/WE are not entitled to claim any enhancement of rates on any account during the tenure of the contract except revision of minimum wages.

BID PRICE: Shall be quoted per One MLD of Treated Water to the required standards

(Details to be given in Appendix-III)

Any rates quoted in any other manner than the above will summarily rejected.

4. I/We shall be bound by the communication of acceptance of the offer dispatched within the time and I/We also agree that if the date up to which the offer would remain open be declared a holiday for the GHMC, the offer will remain open for acceptance till the next working day.
5. I/We do hereby declare that the entries made in the bid and appendixes/schedules attached with 1 Bid are true and also that we shall be bound by the act of my/our duly constituted attorney, Shri _____ whose signature are appended here to in the space as specified for the purpose and of any other person who in future may be appointed by me/us his stead to carry on the business of the concern whether any intimation of such charge is given to the Commissioner, GHMC or not.

DETAILS OF SERVICES

1. Identification of appropriate site for installation of the Equipments /Instruments and necessary support system in consultation with GHMC or any agency authorized/ identified by it.
2. Installation, operate and maintain the installed system of treatment at site with its security
3. Providing necessary civil intervention at the site, without compromising the natural attributes of the drains and conditions imposed by the government agency extending NOC for carrying out the pollution control interventions.
4. Cleaning of floating and suspended solid waste materials from the drains and Sludge/Silt arising from de-sludge/desilting activity performed and its proper storage, transportation and disposal as per provision of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 in collaboration with agency identified by GHMC.
5. Desilting and de-sludging of the drains as and when required by GHMC or its authorized officials/agencies OR for the smooth operation and optimized performance of Geo Tubes.
6. Treatment of drain water to improve the water quality on 24 hour basis for 270 days (except for monsoon period – 15 June to 15 September) at no capital cost for the Geo Tubes by GHMC.
7. The effluent quality of the proposed Geo Tubes before discharge to the drain at down stream should be minimum of the following to qualify for the bid:
 - a. Less than 30 mg/l of BOD (equivalent of 20 mg/l of TOC).
 - b. The suspended solids should be <50 mg/L.
8. Information on water flow and quality at the u/s and d/s of the Geo Tubes, sludge generation and de-silting/de-sludging, disposal of collected floating. Suspended and solid waste shall be logged properly. These information /data will be subjected to scrutiny of GHMC or any other officer authorised by GHMC on its behalf.
9. The schematic arrangement for treatment of drain and monitoring of the intervention is given in Plate-I. The proposed system of treatment shall be portable in nature and can be shifted to another appropriate location as and when required by GHMC.
10. The “service” as defined in Appendix-II shall be for a period of 5 years and may be extended by GHMC based on its requirement on satisfactory performance and mutual agreed conditions.

11. The necessary facility to support and operate the treatment system including manpower, electric power, security, safety against theft and flood will be the responsibility of the bidder.
12. The qualitative and quantitative data as per requirement of GHMC as mentioned in Appendix-II shall be monitored on real time basis and communicated by the bidder on real time basis to GHMC. Such information will be the basis for payment.
13. The water quality parameters to be monitored and the acceptable technology for their monitoring have been provided in Appendix-VI and the bidder has to install from the specified system. The data generated shall be transferred to GHMC or other servers without any loss of data in text form as details provided in Appendix-VI.
14. The bidder shall install camera to cover the situation of drain at up stream and down stream of Geo Tubes to reflect the status of cleaning work.
15. A flow indicator/ meter shall also be installed at the down stream of any intervention made to pond/store the water in the drain in order to provide sufficient information on the amount of water being treated and being discharge (by-pass) refer Plate-1.
16. The Geo Tubes system may have to be shifted by the Bidder to any other suitable location as specified by GHMC within the contract period and the cost associated with shifting will be reimbursed by GHMC on actual basis.
17. Bidders are required to provide terms & Conditions for shifting Geo Tubes, while submitting the technical bid, however, the cost may be submitted along with Price Bid.
18. GHMC will facilitate NOC from the concern agency to work on the drain, BUT the liability for arrangement of land and space to install, transport, operationalize and dismantle or shift the Geo Tubes shall be the obligation of the bidder at his cost.
19. The payment terms and condition for extending the service as defined in the scope of Work shall be as per the guidelines provided in Appendix-V.
20. There will be no liability with GHMC to create any asset for obtaining the services
21. The bidder shall provide the details on the on-line real time monitoring system with regard to its calibration and validation. GHMC or its authorised agent will witness the calibration or call for calibration at any given time and also may validate the generated data. "Guidelines for Online Continuous Monitoring System for Effluent" published Central Pollution Control Board dt. 7th Nov 2014 will be the followed for system calibration, data validation and technology verification of the real time instruments installed for the monitoring of water quality including the technology selection, data transmission and data management.

STATEMENT ON ELIGIBILITY AND EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. Name and address of the bidder and telegraphic address:
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II COMPOSITION OF BIDDER:

It shall be state whether the bidder is business proprietorship concern or registered partnership firm or a Limited Company. The name and date of birth of all partners/Director, Proprietors shall be given. It shall be certified that there are no undisclosed partners. In the case of Limited companies, the authorized and paid up capital shall be stated.

III BUSINESS IN WHICH THE BIDDER IS EMPLOYED:

The nature of business in which the bidder or partner of the tender's firm are engaged shall state together with particulars of where Head Office and branches if any, are located along with details of sister concern.

IV Eligibility and Experience of Working:

1. Bidder shall have successfully completed / under Operation at least one similar work of 50% capacity during last three years preceding the month of the date of publication of NIT.
2. The annual turnover of the bidder in the last three financial years ending 31.3.2017 shall be not less than 1.0 Crores. The bidder should submit a certificate issued by Chartered Accountant and/ or Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account for the above financial years.
3. In case of Joint Venture/ Consortium, the JV/Consortium full fill the criteria mentioned and submit the proof of document as single or JV/Consortium. Maximum three partners are allowed in the JV. The bidder (all members in case of JV) shall submit the list of all ongoing and completed projects anywhere in India in similar nature; Documentary proof of specific performance report issued by the Client for each projects to be submitted.
4. All members of the JV shall jointly meet the qualifying norms in respect to work experience & turn over requirement.
5. All the Consortium member(s) shall authorize the lead partner by submitting a power of Attorney as per the prescribed format duly signed by the authorized signatories. The lead partner shall be authorized to receive instructions for and on behalf of all partners of the Consortium and entire execution of the contract.

6. The Consortium and its members shall be jointly and severally responsible and be held liable for the purpose of guaranteed obligation and any other matter as required under the contract.
7. The lead/associate partner in the JV cannot create a JV with other firm/consultant for same package.
8. Bidder (Single or JV or all partner of JV) should not have been black listed by any Central or State Govt. /any other Govt. Agency and submit an undertaking on firm's letter head in this respect.
9. Bid shall be complete and covering the entire scope of job and shall confirm to the General and Special Conditions indicated in the bid documents. Incomplete and non- confirming bids will be rejected outright.

Notes:

1. Qualifying marks for evaluation of price bid will be equal or more than 60 marks in aggregate.
2. An independent selection committee will be formed for the evaluation of the technical & price bids.
3. The GHMC, however, reserves the right to restrict the list of such qualified service providers to any number deemed suitable by it.

Price Bid Evaluation:

The Price Bids of the technically qualified bidders who have obtained minimum technical score of 70 marks shall be opened in the presence of such bidders representatives who choose to attend.

The contract will be awarded to the Bidder whose Bid has been determined to be responsive to the bidding documents and who has offered the lowest evaluated Bid Price.

Final Score for selection of the Bidder

(a) The service is classified as highly complex, having down stream consequences and requires specialized expertise in extending service of technical and scientific nature. Therefore, the weight age for technical score and financial score has been considered in the ratio of 70:30. The technically qualified bid will be subjected to the following formula for deciding the final score.

$$\text{Final score} = (\text{Technical Score} * 0.7) + (\text{Financial Score} * 0.3)$$

For bid evaluation, the disposal lead distance shall be taken as 10 Km and desilting/ de-sludge quantity shall be taken as 30 m³/ month. These quantities are purely for evaluation purpose and payments shall be on actuals.

Note:

1. C1, C2, C3 and C4 are to be quoted by the bidder in INR.
2. Bids will be evaluated based on bid price calculated for a day, as per formula below. The bid price for each drain so calculated is purely for evaluation and payment shall be on actual only.

$$\text{Bid Price} = \text{C1} + (10 * \text{C2}) + \text{C3} + \text{C4}$$

3. Bid Price for the package will be calculated after adding bid price for all drains in the package (in Rs.) as calculated in Note (4) above.

4. For the purpose of calculation of mobilization advance, security deposit and performance guarantee for each package, the value of contract for the package shall be calculated after adding value of contract for each drain in the package as under.
